

## I. "STATE SCHEME":-

### **1) "Augmentation of silk worm Seed production including modernization of infrastructure/Equipment/Re-plantation at Departmental farms/centres."**

- (a) To provide support to the existing Departmental Mulberry, Eri and Muga Farm for sufficient Production of Silkworm Seeds (Mulberry, Eri and Muga) .
- (b) To upgrade to existing infrastructures of the Departmental Seeds farms (Mulberry, Eri and Muga) including modernization of equipments .
- (c) Programme on re-plantation of Silkworm host plant in the existing Departmental Sericulture Farms (Mulberry, Eri and Muga) and centres.

### **2) "Technical back up Support of Extension services in the fields"**

The objective of the scheme is to provide effective Technical Back up Support to the Mulberry rearer by the Departmental Extension Centres in rearing of silkworm for a better cocoon output with latest Technical Assistance at a farmers level. Demonstration cum transfer of new technology would be provided to the Eri and Muga farmers.

### **3) "Promotion and upgradation of Sericulture training programme".**

The main objective of the schemes is to organize and identify the new Sericultural farmers of Eri, Muga and Mulberry for enhancement of silk production in the State by ways of imparting training on the know-how of Sericulture technique in raising of plantation, rearing of silkworm, production of cocoon etc.,

### **4) "Silk Reeling Centres"**

The main objective of the scheme is to upgrade the existing spinning centres for higher production of silk to meet the demand of raw silk in handloom sector of the state.

### **5) "Intensive Development of Mulberry Silk Industry".**

The main objective of the scheme is the development of Mulberry sector in the district for better production both qualitatively and quantitatively.

### **6) "Intensive Development of Eri Silk Industry".**

The main objective of the scheme is to upscale the rearing and production of Eri in the district.

The Budget Allotment for the above State Schemes was ` 72,86,341/-

## II. "CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEME"

### 1) "Catalytic Development Programme".

- (a) Augmentation of Eri Perennial food plants.
- (b) Assistance for construction of Rearing House.
- (c) Augmentation of Muga Food Plants.

Through the Catalytic Development Schemes (CSS) there has been an increase in the acreage of food plants especially Muga and Eri. Assistance of plantation and construction of Rearing House has helped upscale the production per unit area.

The Budget Allotment of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme during the 11<sup>th</sup> Plan Period till 2009 – 2010 was ` 1,26,44,900/-
