

CHAPTER 13

THE MANNER OF EXECUTION OF SUBSIDY PROGRAMMES

1) Name of programme/schemes

The names of programme/schemes are

- I) Subsidised cost of feeds etc.
- II) Construction of Community Fishery project
- III) Construction of Mini Barrage/Check dam.

2) Duration of programme/scheme

3) Objective of the programme

The Objective of the programme is to identify feasible area for pond construction with a view to augment fish production and to create employment opportunity especially in the rural areas

5) Eligibility of Beneficiary

Any genuine citizen of Meghalaya who own a plot of land for construction of fishery pond.

Any authentic documents of land holding/patta and No objection certificate for respective sardar/headman etc.

7) Procedure to avail the benefits of the programme

The beneficiary has to apply in a prescribe application form issue by the department from time to time.

8) Criteria for deciding eligibility

The Criteria for deciding eligibility is based on the feasibility of the project subject to final recommendations/approval by the respective district Advisory Committee constituted by the Government.

9) Details of the benefits given in the programme (also mention the amount of subsidy or other help given)

The details of benefits given in the programme is subsidy in cash @ 50% of the construction cost of the project i.e. Rs.3, 60,000 per 1.00 ha. Of water area.

10) Procedure for the distribution of the subsidy

The procedure for the distribution of the subsidy is as per technical feasibility of the project duly recommended by the district Advisory Committee.

11) Where to apply or whom to contact in the office for applying

The applicants/beneficiary have to apply through the respective Officer at the Superintendent of Fisheries of the district.

12) Application fee (where applicable)

No fee is charged for the application form except for fish farmer development agency scheme where Rs. 5 is charged.

13) Other fees (where applicable)

No other fee is charged.
